

THE MIGRATION LIBRARY



The collection

The collection of the Migration Library includes literature on

- migration
- the situation in the countries of origin
- migration policy
- integration
- racism and ethnic relations
- other phenomena that are closely related to migration

The collection of the library consists of approximately 12 000 volumes and 60 periodicals.

Right of use and lending

The library is open to all. The lending time is 28 days. Reference books and periodicals are not lent outside the Finnish Immigration Service; they can be consulted in the library.

Returning loans

Loans can be returned to the library during the opening hours, or to the reception of the Finnish Immigration Service (address Lautatarhankatu 10, opposite to the library), which is open Monday to Friday between 8 am and 4.15 pm.
