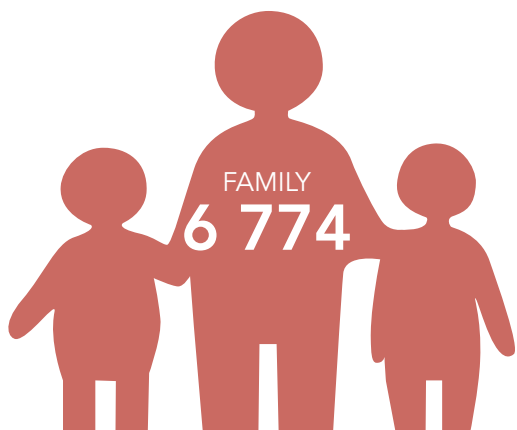
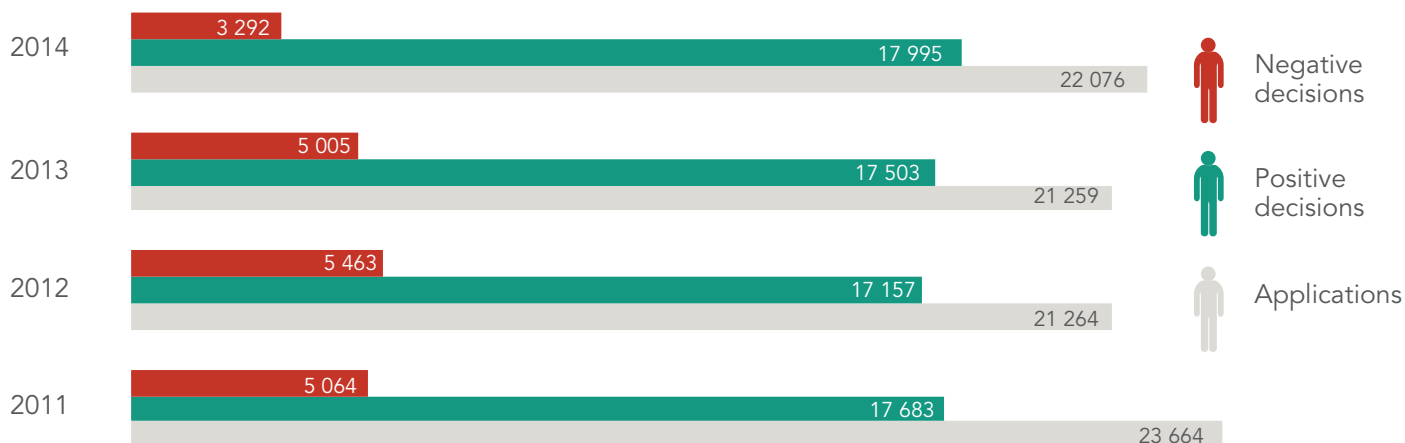


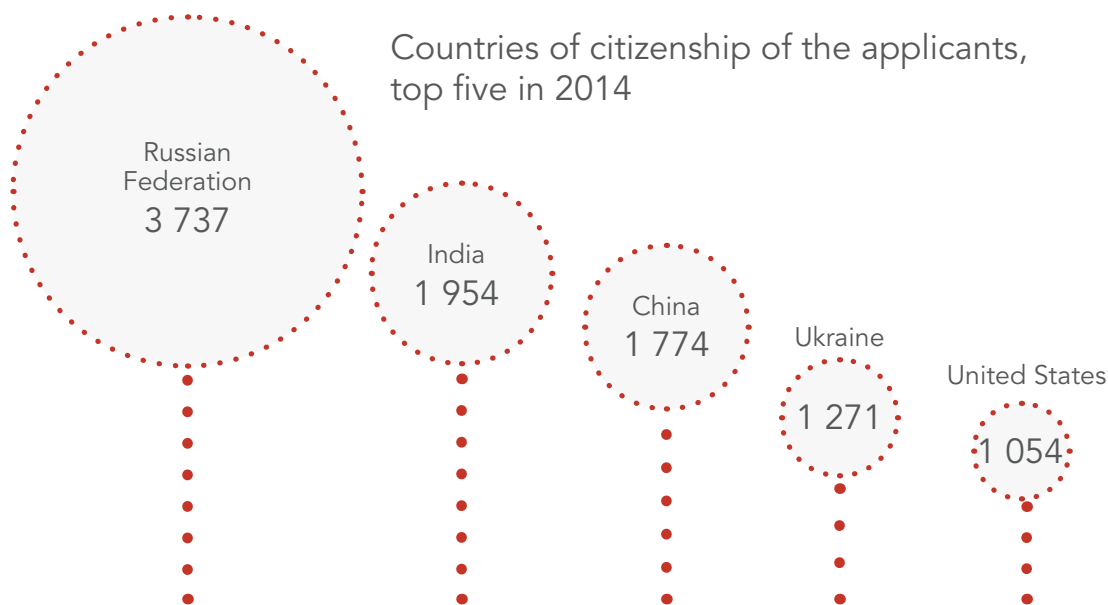
First residence permits issued by the Finnish Immigration Service in 2014 by grounds for applying



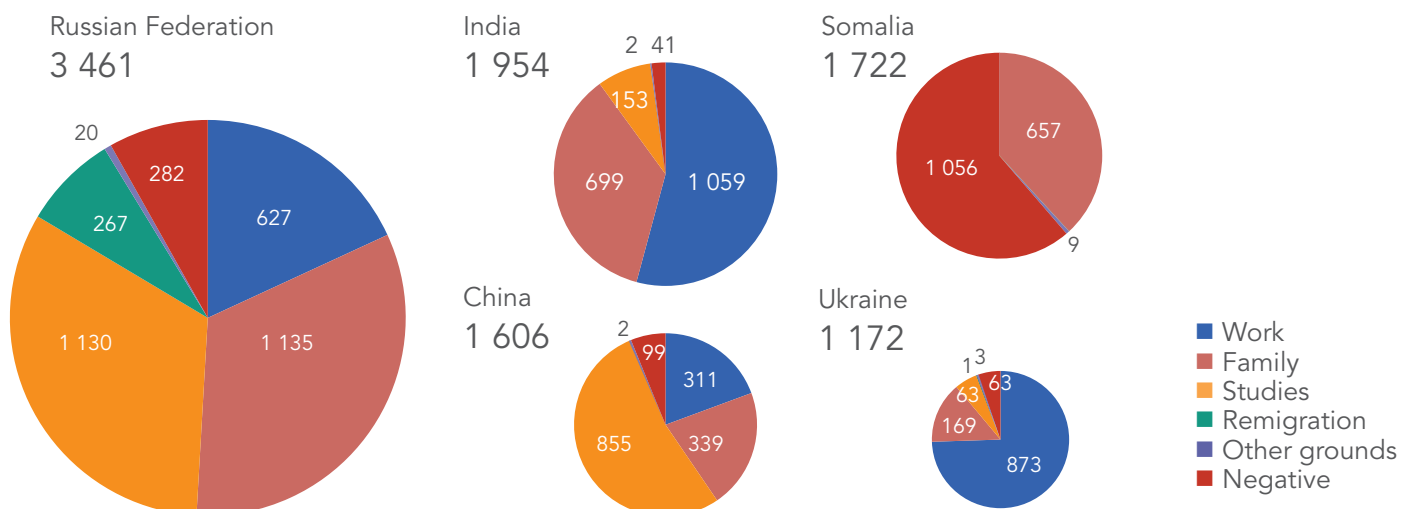
Residence permit applications, positive and negative decisions 2011–2014



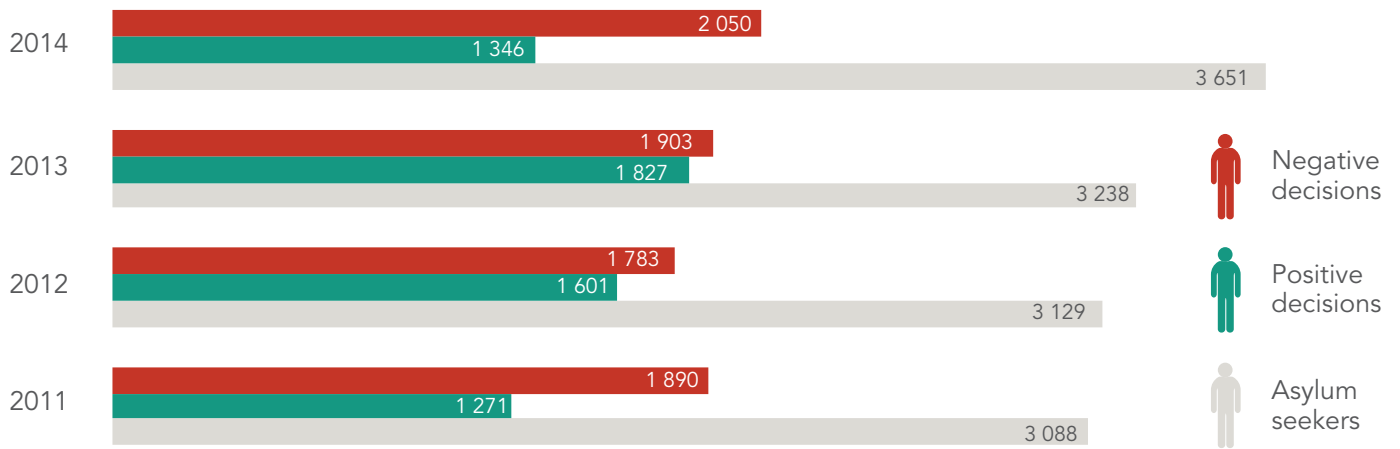
Countries of citizenship of the applicants, top five in 2014



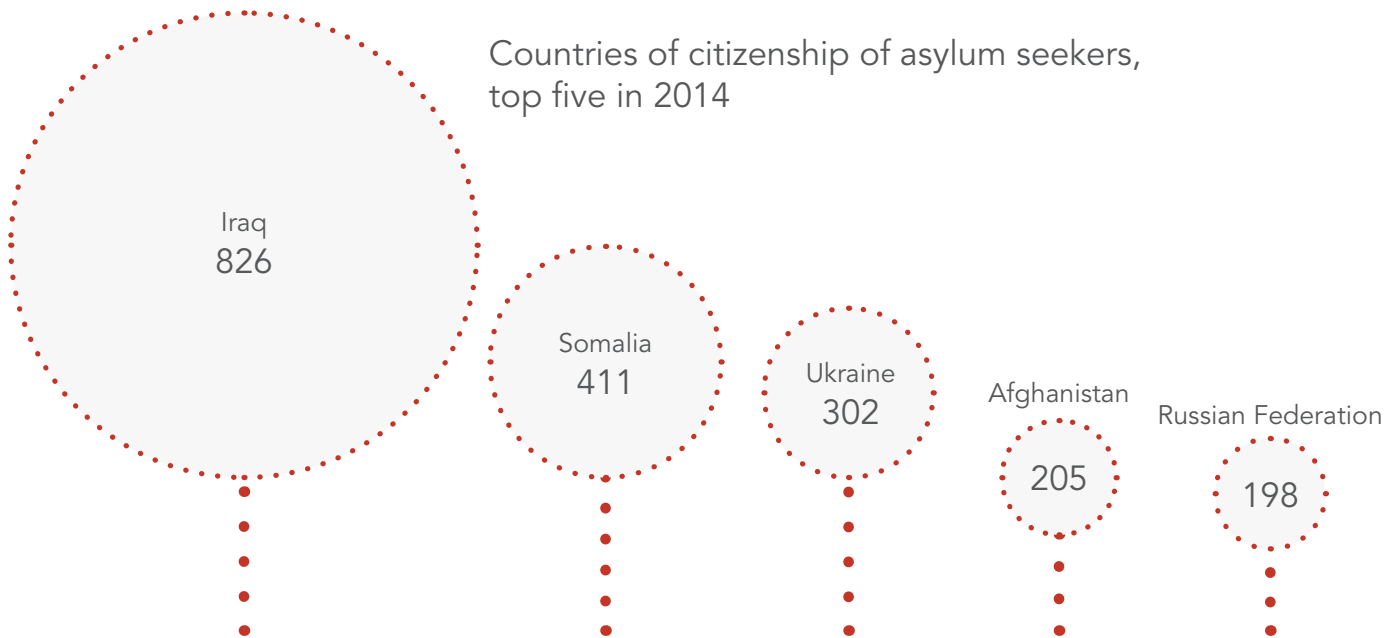
Residence permit decisions by country of citizenship, top five in 2014



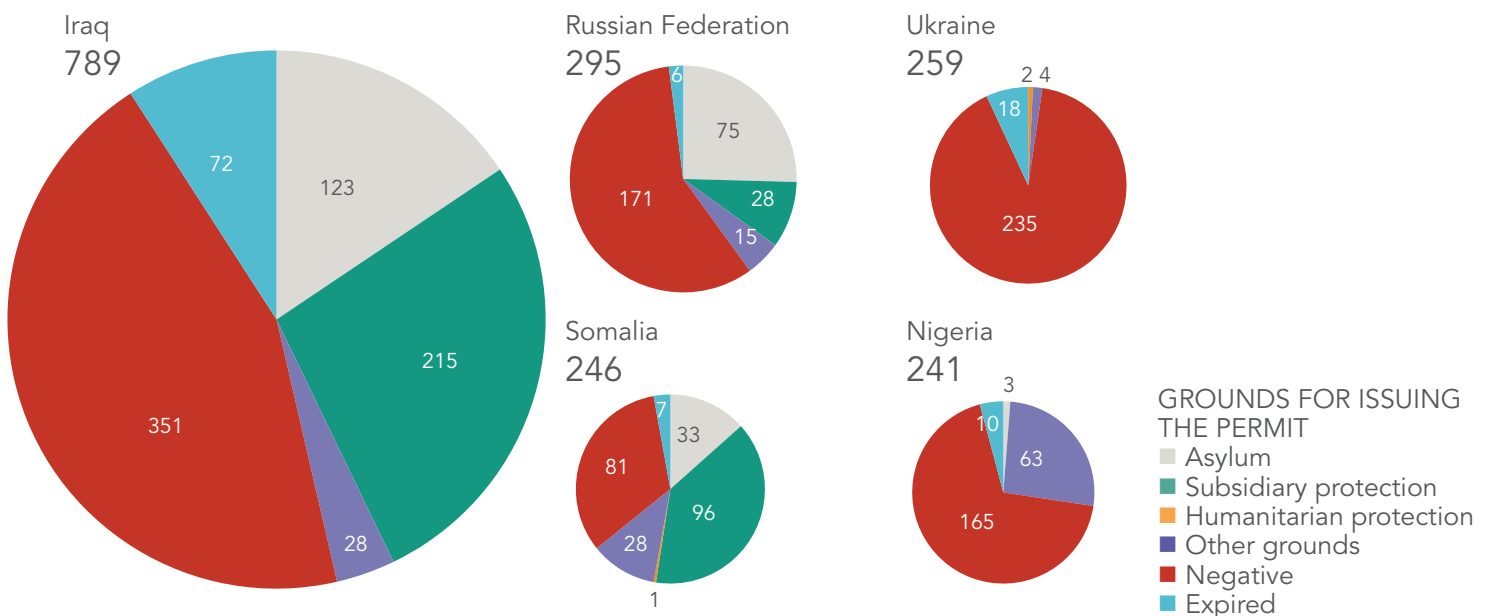
Asylum seekers, positive and negative decisions 2011–2014

Asylum decisions by country of citizenship, top five in 2014

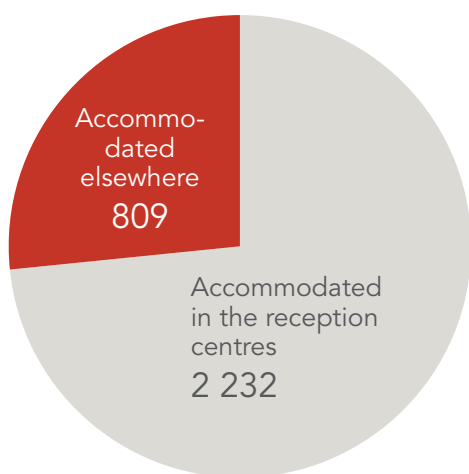

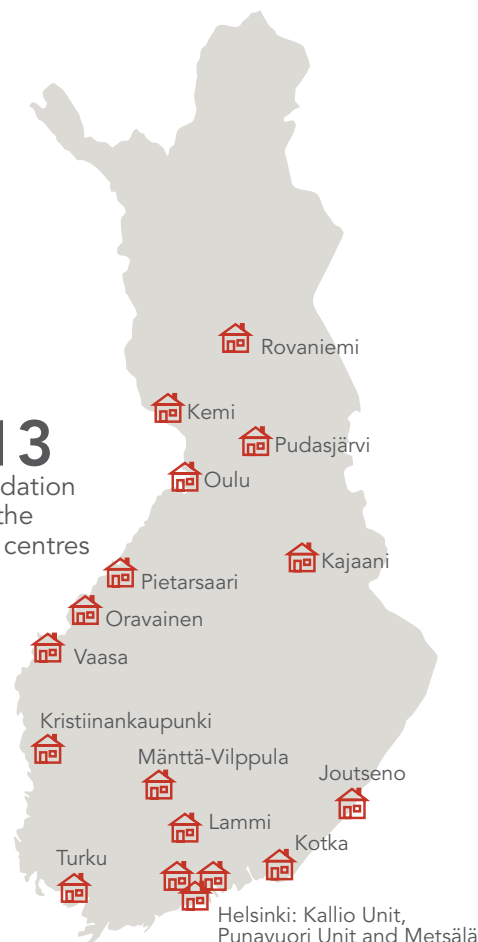
Accommodation of asylum seekers in 2014*



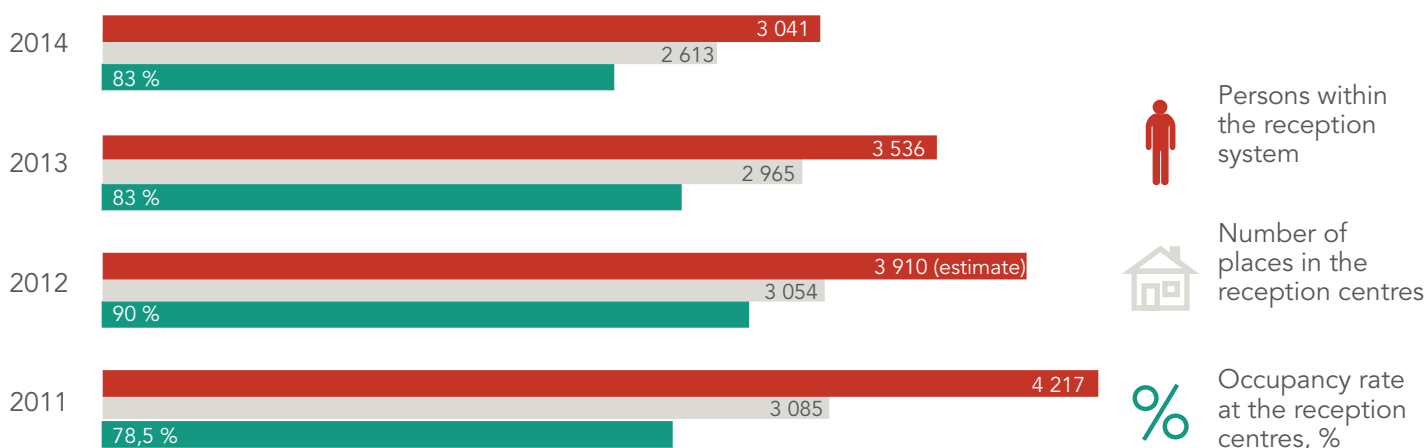
Locations of the reception centres on 1 January 2015

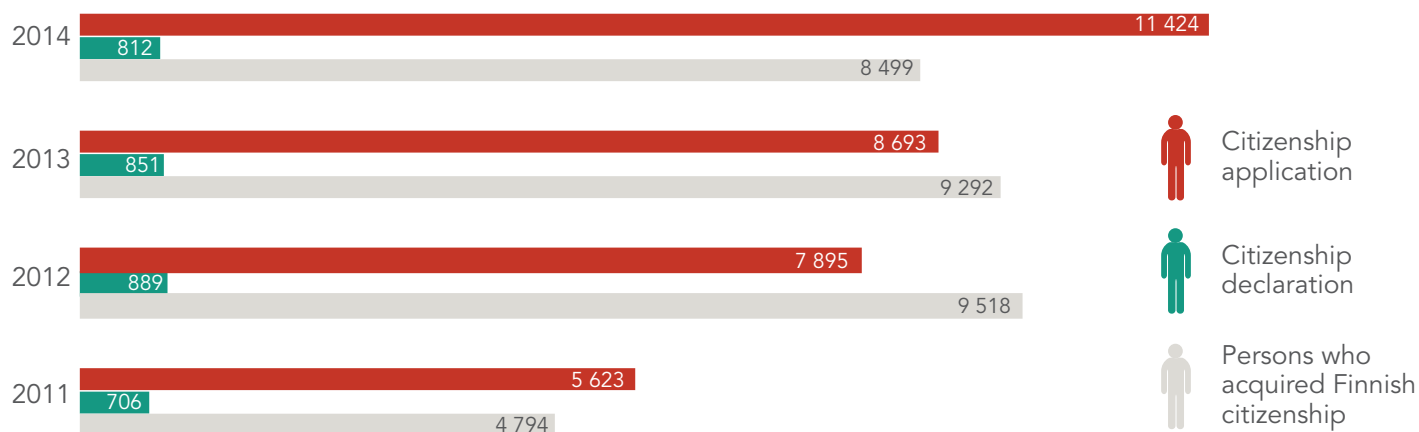


Occupancy rate at the reception centres 2011–2014*

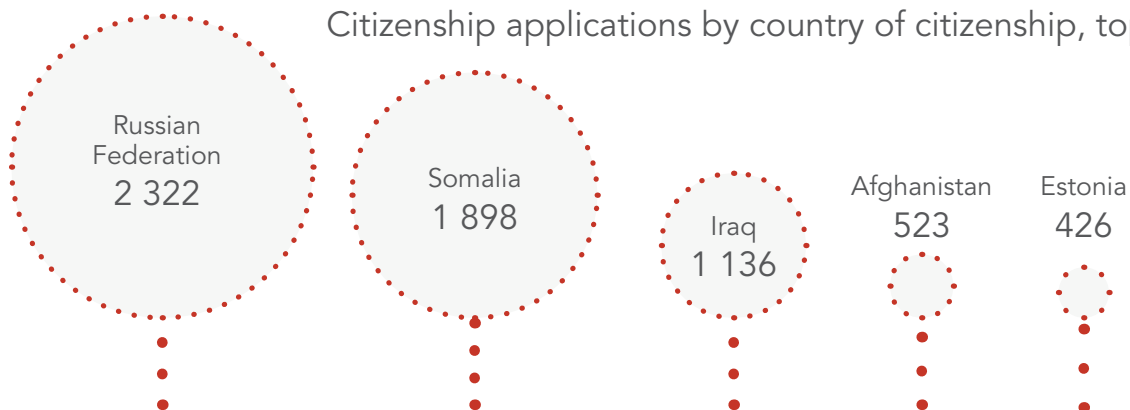

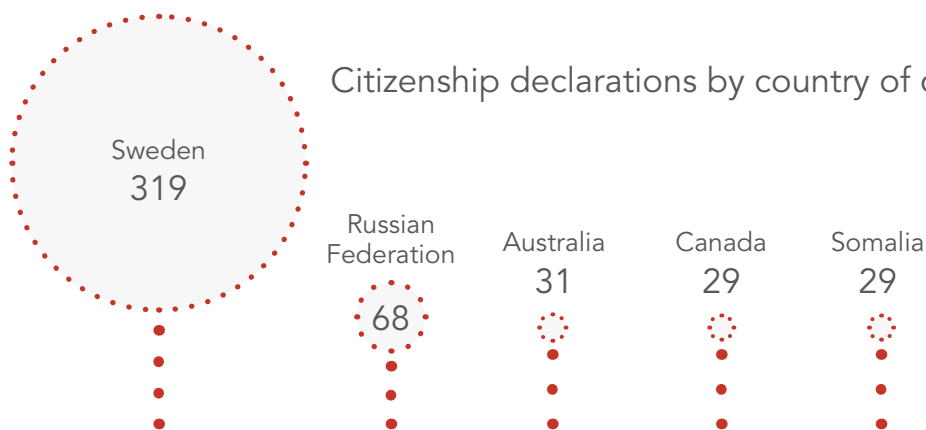
Citizenship applications and declarations as well as persons who acquired Finnish citizenship in 2014
