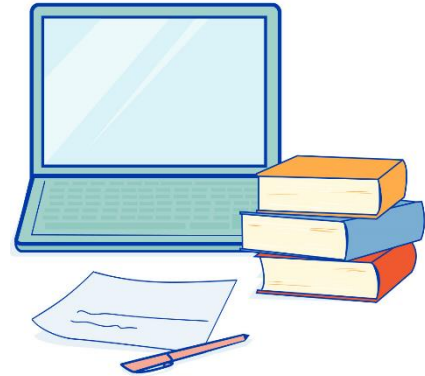


Finnish society course for reception centre customers

The Finnish society course gives important information to all reception centre customers on Finnish society, Finnish legislation, the history of Finland and Finnish customs.



Obligation to complete the course

All reception centre customers are obliged to complete the course by reading the materials for independent study and completing the online course. In addition, lectures will be organised for those who are obliged to participate in work and study activities.

Read the materials for independent study

All reception centre customers must read through the course materials for independent study. The materials are available in 13 languages on the Finnish Immigration Service's website at migri.fi/en/finnish-society-course.

If necessary, the reception centre employees can help you find the materials on the website. You can also ask to receive the materials on paper from your reception centre.

Complete the online course

All reception centre customers must complete the online course. Your reception centre will give you instructions and IDs for taking the course. If necessary, you can use the reception centre's computer, tablet or phone to complete the course.

Attend the lectures

Lectures will be organised for those who are obliged to participate in work and study activities. Your reception centre will invite you to the lectures that are part of the work and study activities. The lectures cover different subjects.

Completion of the course is monitored

Reception centres and the Finnish Immigration Service monitor the completion of the course.

Records will be made to your customer information that you have been informed of the course and the materials for independent study and that you have completed the course and attended the course lectures.
