

Citizenship declaration for adults (one parent Finnish citizen)

① You can apply for Finnish citizenship with this declaration form in the following cases:

- You were born abroad outside marriage on 1 June 2003 or later. Only your father is a Finnish citizen.
 - You were born abroad on 1 June 2003 or later and you have two mothers. Only your non-birth mother is a Finnish citizen.
 - You were born in Finland on 1 June 2003 or later. Your Finnish father's paternity or your Finnish mother's maternity has been established after you have reached 18 years of age.

 3. Submit your declaration form at a Finnish mission (finlandabroad.fi) if you are abroad, or at a service point of the Finnish Immigration Service if you are in Finland.
 4. Citizenship declarations are subject to a fee. Pay the processing fee when you submit the declaration form. We will not start processing the declaration until you have paid the fee.
