



Request to determine citizenship status

① Use this form if you wish to determine your or your child's citizenship status.

You can ask us to determine your citizenship status if your citizenship information in the Population Information System is not correct or if you need a decision by an authority on what citizenship you are considered to hold in Finland. The decision will be issued in Finnish or Swedish.

1. For instructions on how to fill in the form, on processing fees and on the attachments required, see migri.fi/determination-of-citizenship.
2. Fill in the form carefully. Remember to sign the form. If any information is missing, this will delay the processing of the request and may lead to the request being rejected.

The attachments needed for the request are listed on this form under 'Attachments'.

3. The processing fee for the request is 100 euros. Pay the processing fee into the bank account of the Finnish Immigration Service before you submit the request.
