

Supplement form: Suomen kansalaisen vapaan liikkumisoikeuden käyttö

① Attach this supplement form to your application if you are a family member of a Finnish citizen and are applying for the registration of the right of residence of an EU citizen or a residence card for a family member of an EU citizen on the basis of family ties.

Before your application can be decided, the Finnish Immigration Service must investigate whether your family member, who is a Finnish citizen, has exercised his or her right of free movement.

Exercising the right of free movement means that your family member, who is a Finnish citizen, must have lived in another EU country or in a country comparable to the EU Member States for at least three months without interruption on the basis of work, pursuing a trade, studies or family ties or alternatively had sufficient funds of his or her own to support his or her stay. During that period, he or she must have had a family life with you.

1. Answer the questions on this supplement form together with your family member. Also your family member must sign the documents concerning him or her.
2. Our languages of contact are Finnish, Swedish and English. Have the documents translated into one of these languages by an authorised translator.
3. Attach the supplement form to your application.
