There are a total of 41 units in operation. In addition to the centres, there are in total 9 units of private accommodation around Finland and two units of temporary sheltering in Seinäjoki and Tampere.

The occupancy rate was 85 % on 21.4.2022.

About 22 200 adults/family members are registered on the reception system. In addition to officially registered, about 2 000 people are not officially registered to reception system, because some information systems are not yet in use in new reception centres.
