① If you wish to apply for an extension, you must submit your application within the time limit set for voluntary return in the decision on removal from the country.

① Extending the time limit for voluntary return is always exceptional. The time limit may only be extended on very serious grounds.

ⓘ A decision on denial of admittance or stay or on deportation sets a time limit of at least seven and no more than thirty days within which the foreign national may leave the country voluntarily. The time limit for voluntary return is counted from the day the decision is enforceable. The time limit may be extended for special reasons. Extending the time limit for voluntary return is always an exceptional measure. (Aliens Act, section 147a).
