Permanent residence permit application

① Use this form if you are at least 18 years of age and applying for a permanent residence permit for yourself. If possible, use the online service Enter Finland to apply for the permit. The online service will help you choose the right application.

① If you already have a permanent residence permit and your residence permit card expires soon, apply for a new residence permit card.

① If you do not meet the requirements for a permanent residence permit, we will examine whether you can be granted a continuous residence permit (A permit).

Which application path are you using to apply for a permanent residence permit?

① If you have been issued with a residence permit on the basis of refugee status or subsidiary protection status, your period of residence is calculated from the date of your arrival in Finland.

- Residence of 6 years:** I have lived in Finland for at least 6 years under a continuous residence permit (A permit) or a Brexit permit, I have at least 2 years of work history in Finland, and the level of my Finnish or Swedish language skills is *satisfactory* (level B1). **①** If you have reached 65 years of age, the language skills requirement does not apply to you. - Higher education degree completed outside Finland:** I have lived in Finland for at least 4 years under a continuous residence permit (A permit) or a Brexit permit, I have a master's degree or a licentiate or doctoral degree recognised in Finland and at least 2 years of work history in Finland.
- Particularly good language skills:** I have lived in Finland for at least 4 years under a continuous residence permit (A permit) or a Brexit permit, I have at least 3 years of work history in Finland, and the level of my Finnish or Swedish language skills is *particularly good* (level C1).
