



## Document certifying a British citizen's rights as a frontier worker

**① Use this form if you are British citizen and**

- **if you have been working in Finland as a frontier worker already before the transition period ended on 31 December 2020, and**
- **you want to apply for a document under the withdrawal agreement certifying that you are a frontier worker protected by the withdrawal agreement.**

4. The application is subject to a fee. Please pay the processing fee when you submit the application. We will not start processing your application before you have paid the processing fee.
