

# Document certifying a British citizen's rights as a frontier worker

- you want to apply for a document under the withdrawal agreement certifying that you are a frontier worker protected by the withdrawal agreement.

- 2. Fill in the form carefully. Remember to sign the form. If any information is missing, this will delay the processing of the application and may lead to the application being rejected. The attachments needed for the application are listed in this form under "Attachments".
- 3. Submit your application at a Service point of the Finnish Immigration Service or at a Finnish mission (embassy or consulate).
- 4. The application is subject to a fee. Please pay the processing fee when you submit the application. We will not start processing your application before you have paid the processing fee.
